

10. Executive Component: Organization Chart




11. Student Feedback on Institutional Governance/faculty performance

12.Grievance redressal mechanism for faculty, staff and students

- Institute has a system for redressal of grievances of faculty, staff and students.
- The management of the institute follows an open system of administration and grievances from staff and students are given the utmost attention.
- Complaints and suggestion boxes are kept at a number of places in the campus and also in the hostels.
- The suggestions and complaints are carefully looked into and remedial measures undertaken.
- In case of indiscipline, a committee appointed by the Director enquires into the matter by calling witnesses and recommendations are made about the action to be taken by the management.
- Grievances regarding the staff in terms of salary, promotions etc., are carefully looked after by the HR department.
- Class Representative (CR) meetings are held in which grievances of students are taken and resolved.
